SOUTH BEND — There will be a Festival of African Marriage Traditions from 2 to 7:30 p.m. June 14 at the University of Notre Dame's Center for Arts & Culture, 1045 W. Washington St.

The family-friendly event will include presentations about marriage traditions in four African nations: Ghana, Kenya, Malawi and Rwanda. There also will be African food and music.
